- After the third read What is said about God?

LEARN

Leader reads out loud again

- What do these passages mean to you?
- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about our relationship with God?

LIFE

Here is a formula - Always Faithful + Truth about God = Who God is

For Example:

Always Faithful to Love you

Always Faithful to have Mercy on You

Always Faithful to bring Peace

Always Faithful in Wise Living

Always Faithful to give Grace
